2020 ANNUAL MEETING

April 23, 24-26, 2020

Please join the Barrow Family Association's 2020 Annual Meeting at the Smithfield Station Hotel Conference Room, 409 South Church Street, Smithfield, VA 23430. The BFA general meeting will be held Saturday, April 25, 2020, and the Board of Directors meeting will be held Friday, April 24, 2020, in the late afternoon at ST. Luke's Historic Church & Museum. For those who would like to do some genealogical research at the Surry Library, the Smithfield/Isle of Wight/ Blackwater Library, the Surry Court House, or the Isle of Wight Court House, please join some of us Thursday, April 23rd, Friday morning, the 24th, and early Friday afternoon. Please consider arriving ahead of the actual 2020 BFA Annual Meeting. There is no requirement to come earlier but some of us will arrive a few days early to do some family research.

The Smithfield Station Hotel has two sections, an older section over the restaurant and a new section (Lodge). Smithfield Station Hotel is offering a 20% reduced rate on rooms when the room booking is made **no later than March 9, 2020**, and cost is prepaid and nonrefundable. This reduced rate is found in parentheses. Lodge room rate is \$189 (\$151) per night. The older section's room rate depends on the floor. The Lodge has an elevator whereas the older section does not. 2nd floor room rate in the older section is \$169 (\$135) and 3rd floor of the older section room rate is \$139 (\$121). Added to the above listed room rates are the occupancy and sales taxes. Free Breakfast is included every morning except for Sunday. All other meals are at your own expense. It is suggested that Sunday's breakfast be held at the Cockeyed Rooster Cafe. Hotel Check-In at 3:00 pm.

Rooms may be reserved over the phone at 1-757-357-7700. Extension 1. You must 1. **request the discount**, and 2. Mention "**Barrow Family Association**") before March 9th. The Barrow block rooms will be held until March 9, 2020, after that date the room rates revert-back to their original rate. Parking is available in front of Smithfield Station Hotel or directly across the street.

There are three local airports: Richmond, Norfolk and Newport News. Check each for best rates. From the Richmond Airport, Surry is about an hour's drive and Smithfield is another half hour drive on Route 10. In Surry is the Surry Historical Society (open Tuesday and Wednesday only), Surry Library (open all week) and Surry Court House (open weekdays, no cell phones allowed). Smithfield/Isle of Wight/Blackwater Library is extensive and open every day except Sundays., the Smithfield Court House (no cell phones) is about 6 miles outside of Smithfield. There is an Isle of Wight Historical Society, IOWHS, online. Suggest that you have the "Scannable" apt on your cell phone for the libraries. No cell phones are allowed in the Court Houses, printing is \$0.50/page.

The meeting's cost is \$30 per person and includes a Friday docent tour (\$5) of ST. Luke's Historic Church & Museum; (3 miles east of Smithfield) use of meeting rooms and coffee, tea or water and a special pastry on Saturday morning.
